This Time Tomorrow, where will you be?

What we do on Monday morning is just as important as what we do on Sunday morning! Yet sometimes we can think that God is only bothered about how we worship him when we come together as a church on Sundays.

Yet God made Mondays not just Sundays. As the creator of everything he is the original worker. This means that all work whether it's paid or unpaid, full-time or part-time, at home or in the workplace has a God-given dignity and honour. God cares about what we do on Monday mornings, not just what we do at church on Sunday mornings.

God is also sovereign over every detail of our lives. That means that where we are and what we do through the week is not random. Wherever you will be tomorrow morning, God has placed us there to worship him by working in a way that loves him and loves our neighbours.

All work is therefore a good gift from God, yet all work is also under the curse because of human sin. This means that whatever we do will involve frustration and toil.

We spend only a small part of each week with one another as a church family before scattering through the rest of the week. It may well be that you sit next to the same people every Sunday with no idea what they will be doing through the rest of the week. If that is the case then why not ask them...

“This time tomorrow, where will you be?”

“What will you be doing?”

“What are some of the joys and challenges of doing that?”

“How can I pray for you?”
